

**INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP IN CARDIOVASCULAR
PHYSIOLOGY**

Signal transduction in cardio-vascular system

13-16 May 2004, Warsaw, Poland

The Workshop will focus on the main mechanisms and experimental methods for studying cardiovascular system. The meeting is sponsored by The Physiological Society and is intended primarily for young scientists from Central and Eastern European countries and from other European countries, though participants from other countries are also very welcome. The programme will consist of lectures, lunchtime poster sessions, round tables and laboratory sessions. During the conference posters will be selected and be given the opportunity for short oral presentations. Prizes will be presented for the best presentations. The Workshop language is English.

Up to 50 applications will be accepted. Preference will be given for applicants who will present a poster. Interested applicants should submit a short CV including contact details, a publication list and a letter of recommendation from their supervisor or laboratory or institute head. Applicants are asked to email these documents and the abstract for the poster presentation, as RTF (Rich Text Format) documents to Professor Andrzej Beresewicz at aberesew@cmkp.edu.pl
